Don't include apostrophes, hyphens, or spaces.

Your password is your member ID which is found just to the left of the date on
The TAO magazine label.

Once you are in click on UPDATE PERSONAL INFORMATION.

Please check that the information is correct. If you find mistakes, please correct them. If you can not make the necessary changes please contact me, scrumpler@gmail.com and I will send in requests to national for you.

When finished, be sure you go to the end and POST CHANGES.

We are going to be receiving to our email box/ or by US mail if you do not have an email address, an invoice to make your dues easy to pay online or to mail.
